Who provides the training?

Richard Warrington, 3Di software developer and training manager at University College London.

What does the training include?

"A revolutionary, computer based interview for the diagnosis of autism and related disorders in children"

3Di is a computer based programme used to diagnose autism and related disorders in children. Its main features include:

- computes the severity of features associated with a diagnosis of autism
- computes levels of behavioural adjustment
- establishes comorbidity across the full range of child psychiatric disorders
- generates a comprehensive report suitable for parents and referrers
- liked by parents
- excellent reliability and validity; criterion validity established in relation to the ADI-R
- no double-entry: for research, all data can be exported so SPSS
- provides an audit trail invaluable for clinical governance

The interview emulates Autism Diagnostic Interview (ADI-R) algorithms, but unlike that interview it is focused largely on current rather than historical behaviour of note. Consequently, it has high levels of agreement with the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS) in clinically significant autistic disorders. It is also DSM-5 compatible.

What do you need?

Laptops will be supplied for the course.

- At the completion of the course to install the program on your own laptop or desk-top you will need Microsoft Windows (XP or later) and to have the 32bit version of Microsoft Office installed (including Word 2003 or later).
- The 3Di will run on Apple Macs, but only by installing a virtual machine such as Parallels or VMware Fusion - on which a Windows operating system and Microsoft Office would need to be installed. Windows XP and Word 2003 are fine - later versions are also fine. Both programs cost less than AUD\$80 online.
