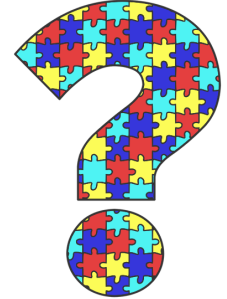

WHAT DOES THE TRAINING INCLUDE?

This 2-day online training will focus on providing mental health clinicians working with adults further practical tools for working with autistic adults. Topics covered will include:

- Best practice tools and processes for screening and diagnostic assessment of ASD in adults.
- Common comorbid mental health and neurodevelopmental issues in Autistic adults.
- Adapting mental health interventions for Autistic adults including prescription of psychiatric medication, supporting emotional regulation, sensory modulation and supporting relationships and communication.
- Linking autistic adults with community supports.

Please note this training does not focus on moderate to severe intellectual disability and associated behavioural interventions. Please contact Mindful for further information with regards to training options in this area.
