- Undertaking mental health & wellbeing assessments, developing formulations, diagnoses and creating treatment plans.

### Who

Professionals working with children and adolescents with mental health difficulties, including social workers, occupational therapists, psychiatric nurses, speech pathologists, psychologists, educators, support workers and counsellors.

- Theory standalone VIC applicants: \$2,000 (Incl GST)
- Theory standalone Non-Victorian applicants: \$2,325 (Incl GST)
