WHAT DOES THE TRAINING INCLUDE?

This workshop will focus on Autism and ADHD in children 0 -12 and adolescents (diagnosed in childhood). This workshop will help participants to understand:

- What is ADHD and how common is ADHD in autistic children and adolescents.
- Key co-occurring features.
- Overview of assessment process for ADHD in the context of autism or autism assessment.
- Best practice supports and practical strategies for ADHD and co-occurring autism.
- Lived experience perspectives of the diagnostic process and parenting neurodivergent children will be incorporated throughout.

Whilst this workshop does not focus on late diagnosis in adolescents or adults, current clinical challenges will also be discussed.
