Autism Clinical Interview for Adults

What is the ACIA?

The Autism Clinical Interview for Adults (ACIA) is a semi-structured interview tool that can be used to support Autism diagnostic assessment for people aged 16+. Consisting of a questionnaire and interview, the assessment tool covers autism traits, strengths and difficulties, and co-occurring physical and mental health conditions.

What does the training include?

This two-hour live webinar introduces the ACIA as an assessment tool. During this workshop you will:

- Learn about the development and evidence base for the ACIA
- Learn about the key components of the ACIA assessment
- Explore the Pre-Interview Questionnaires and ACIA Subject and Informant versions of the main interview
- Discuss administration and use in clinical practice
- Observe video material of experienced clinicians administering the tool.

Following training, participants will be provided with the official materials to utilise the ACIA in their diagnostic practice.

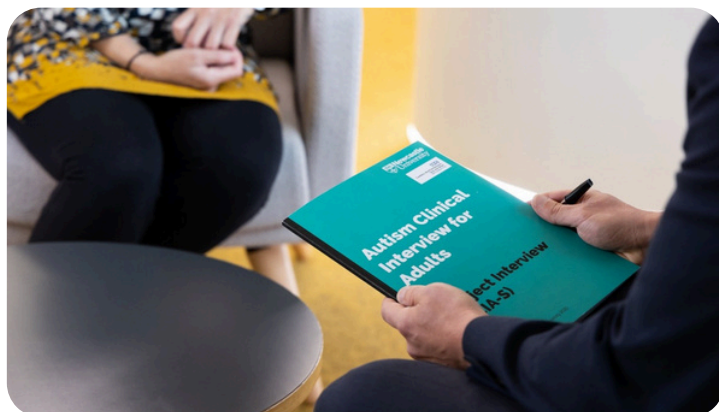
Who is the training for?
