WHAT DOES THE TRAINING INCLUDE?

This 2-day live webinar will focus on providing mental health clinicians working with adults, practical tools for assessing and understanding how autism presents in adults. Topics covered will include:

- Best practice tools and processes for screening and diagnostic assessment of autism in adults.
- Common co-occurring mental health and neurodevelopmental differences in autistic adults.
- Case example of an adult autism assessment, including formulation.
- Neuroaffirming feedback processes and recommendations for post diagnostic support.
- Lived and living experience perspectives.
